



John 5 Bible Study: Meeting Jesus by the Pool

Dive into this John 5 Bible study and discover what it's like to meet Jesus by the pool. Through the guidance of the Holy Spirit, unpack this story of Jesus healing a man by the pool. Listen for the questions Jesus may ask *you* through this story that reveal something deeper about yourself. You can complete this Bible study individually or with a group.

John 5 Bible Study

Read through John 5:1-15 once before going deeper into each section of this Scripture.

Pool of Bethesda

Read John 5:1-5 and then answer the reflection questions below.

1. What do we learn from these verses about when and where this scene took place?	
2. Describe this community pool scene in your own words. Imagine with your senses what this scene would have been like: sights, sounds, smells, etc.	9
3. When in your life have you felt stuck and can relate to this man who has been waiting for his life to change for 38 years?	

Dive Deeper: Read Nehemiah 3:1 about the rebuilding of the Sheep Gate. Also, depending on your Bible translation, there may be a note for John 5:4 that gives more details about the pool of Bethesda. Use a Bible dictionary or commentary for more background info about Bethesda and this pool that may give you deeper insight into this story from John 5.
